# **BIOGRAPHY**

Four time award-winning actress, Kathleen Gati (Best Actress Award - Los Angeles Hungarian Film Festival) was born and raised in Canada by Hungarian immigrants and was brought up in an artistic environment. Her father was a symphony conductor and her mother an opera singer, so performing was in her blood. She started acting at the age of three, wrote, directed and starred in her first play at the age of eight. Studied ballet and acting till the age of eighteen, when she moved to New York to study and pursue her acting career. After performing in dozens of plays both on and Off Broadway, as well as working in numerous roles on television and in film, Kathleen traveled to Hungary to film Goldberg Variations, for which she won the Hungarian Best Supporting Actress Award.

She subsequently stayed on in Hungary for several years, during which time she starred in multiple films, television series and MOWs, winning additional awards along the way. Her performance in Hungary's biggest hit of the '90s, We Never Die (Sose Halunk Meg), made her an extremely popular actress in Eastern and Central Europe. She returned to the States and has worked continuously in New York, Los Angeles and Canada.

Features include Sunshine (Ralph Fiennes), The Future (Miranda July), Transformers: Dark Of The Moon, American Dream (Nick Stahl), Trade (Kevin Kline), Igby Goes Down (Susan Sarandon), ZigZag (John Leguizamo), The Future (Miranda July), The Space Between (Melissa Leo), Meet The Fockers, House Bunny, Little Birds (Juno Temple) and numerous others.

On television, Kathleen Gati is best known for her recurring roles on General Hospital as Dr. Lisa Obrecht, the evil German psychiatrist; two seasons on 24 as Anya Suvarov; on Alphas, series regular on both the Drugstore (Hungary) and in the animation series, Me Eloise with Tim Curry and Lynn Redgrave...plus many Guest roles on series: Fairly Legal, Leverage, Covert Affairs, The Mentalist, Desperate Housewives, Cold Case, The League, Lie To Me, ER, Las Vegas...to name a few.

She carries three passports, Canadian, American and EU/Hungarian and speaks Hungarian, Russian, Spanish and French (besides her first native language, English).
